Art Scout: 11 Must-See Shows Before 2014 Ends, and a Few to Carry You Into 2015

"Susan Te Kahurangi King: Drawings from Many Worlds" at Andrew Edlin Gallery, Through December 20 Independent curator Chris Byrne (co-founder of the Dallas Art Fair and author of the graphic novel *The Magician*) has put together the first U.S. solo show of self-taught New Zealand artist Susan Te Kahurangi. To her credit, there's no easy way to summarize her style, and the exhibition title could be misleading, because her rough representations of pop-culture cartoon characters collaged into chaotic groupings and floating in empty space on white pages could all be tableaus from a single story.
