Art: 'Popular Painters and Other Visionaries'

There are gems throughout this show from El Museo del Barrio in New York City featuring nearly three dozen artists with ties to Latin America.

Some of the most unusual pieces are the intricate collages of Felipe Jesus Consalvos, a Cuban immigrant to the United States. Each work by Consalvos offers a commentary on American life, juxtaposing images as varied as Abraham Lincoln, cigars and a rhinoceros.
